Please answer the following questions **before** completing your paperwork:

Do you meet our income eligibility requirements? Y / N

Our income limit is \$50,000 for individuals and \$75,000 for households of 2-4 people. For families of 5 or more, we increase the limit by \$5,000 for each additional dependent.

Are you here without your spouse (and filing a joint return)? Y / N

Both spouses must be present for all stages of the process when filing a joint return.

Did you forget any of your tax documents? Y / N

This includes your photo identification and social security cards or ITIN letters for everyone on the return. See the reverse side for a checklist of other tax documents you may need.

If you ran your own business, received a Form 1099-MISC or Form 1099-NEC, or received cash/checks for work you did, did you:
