

## Advance Child Tax Credit

### ***How do I know how much of the Advanced Child Tax Credit I received from July through December 2021?***

- **Letter 6419: 2021 Advance Child Tax Credit**
    - Verifies how much you got in advance payments in 2021, and the number of qualifying children used to determine the payouts
    - Letter issued by the IRS in late December, early January
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*What if I didn't receive Letter 6419 and I have official United States identification documents along with access to a cell phone or computer?*

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- **Child Tax Credit Update Portal:** <https://www.irs.gov/credits-deductions/child-tax-credit-update-portal>
    - You can check if you were eligible and/or enrolled for the advanced payments
    - You can view the bank account and mailing address the IRS has on file
    - You can view your prior payments and total payments
  - **If you do not already have an IRS username, you will need to verify your identity:**

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*What if I didn't receive Letter 6419 and do not have official United States identification documents or access to a cell phone or computer?*

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- **Bank Statement (printed copy, or through banking app/website)**
  - Payments made to you for the purposes of ACTC will include the name "IRS TRES 310 DES: CHILDCTC"
- **Checking/debit card:**
  - Most debit cards have a phone number on the backside
  - Locate this phone number, call, and ask how many payments have been made to your account by the IRS or Treasury Department
