

Mailing Returns & Extensions on Tax Day – April 15th, 2020

All 2019 tax returns or extensions MUST be postmarked or e-filed on or before midnight on April 15th, 2020 to be considered on time.

No Austin area Post Offices are open late on Tax Day.

Collection Boxes (blue mailboxes) have final pick-up times between 5pm and 6pm in the Austin area. Be sure to verify the hours of operation and final collection time. A stamped envelope must be deposited in a collection box prior to the last scheduled pick up time to receive the April 15th postmark.

Taxpayers can also use certain private delivery services approved by the IRS. These private delivery services include only UPS, FedEx, and DHL Express. Most local private delivery services have last collection times at 6 or 6:30pm.

Mailing after 5pm on Tax Day?

Consider using the self-service kiosk at a Post Office. (This requires purchasing postage with a credit or debit card.) These are open 24 hours per day and postmark the envelope with the current day's date, even if it is after the final collection time for that USPS location.
