The taxpayer is a surviving spouse filing a joint return (MFJ) with a deceased spouse.	Death Certificate or formal notification from an appropriate office (e.g., Dept of Defense).  Photo ID and proof of SSN/ITIN are required for both spouses. (Death certificate displaying the full SSN of the deceased spouse will be accepted.)	These returns may be e-filed under certain circumstances.  See Policy & Preparation: MFJ with Deceased Spouse and What Must Be a Paper Return?
A court-appointed personal representative (ie, executor or administrator of the estate) is filing for a deceased taxpayer, including for a married deceased taxpayer who will not file MFJ.	Court-appointed representative/ administrator certificate or similar. (A will is not acceptable.) This could include living trust documentation where the person is listed as a trustee, when presented alongside a death certificate.  Photo ID and proof of SSN/ITIN for the taxpayer. (Death certificate displaying the full SSN of the deceased taxpayer will be accepted.)  Photo ID for the court-appointed representative.  Note: FC will not prepare the tax return on behalf of someone other than the surviving spouse or the court-appointed representative. Exceptions to this policy can be made by Tax Help program leadership.	These returns may be e-filed under certain circumstances. The taxpayer is claiming a dependent who is deceased and whose death occurred within the tax year being prepared.	Date of death. Death certificate is not required. Photo ID and proof of SSN/ITIN for primary taxpayer (and spouse if MFJ). Proof of SSN/ITIN for deceased dependent.	These returns may be e-filed under certain circumstances.
