

Schedule C's with over \$25,000 in expenses are out of scope.

Refer to the chart below if the taxpayer listed a high number of miles on the self-employment worksheet.

Here's a quick calculation for 2019 returns!

10,000 miles x .58 = \$5,800 deduction

20,000 miles x .58 = \$11,600 deduction

30,000 miles x .58 = \$17,400 deduction

40,000 miles x .58 = \$23,200 deduction

Reimbursement rate by tax year:

58 cents for 2019

54.5 cents for 2018

53.5 for 2017

54 cents for 2016

If the taxpayer's total expenses for self-employment exceed \$25,000, refer to Special Tax Services!
